## Re: Survey Post Charges

Due to rapidly rising costs, the existing price structure governing the various types of posts available to surveyors through Government Agents' Offices is reflecting an increasing loss over costs to this Department.

An upward revision of prices has therefore become necessary.

Effective immediately, therefore, the following unit prices on survey posts obtainable from government outlets will apply:

It shall remain the policy that the ½" square, galvanized iron, pointed survey post with the expanded head will only be sold to you with the equivalent number of aluminum post caps. Post caps however may be sold independently.
