Existing statutory rights of way shown on statutory rights of way plans submitted to this office must have their boundaries shown in solid lines, otherwise it will be considered a technical error and subject to the \$100 fine as per Circular Letter #312.

Survey Posts

This Branch no longer will be stocking survey posts at Government Agents' offices. When present stocks are depleted, they will not be renewed. All survey posts previously handled by Government Agents can now be ordered from Victoria by phoning 387-4461. Costs of these posts will be invoiced to the surveyor and will be shipped collect to the consignee.
