This information is to include at least the input used and the results obtained in your checking of all closures and areas of each and every lot and all other circuits on the plan capable of being closed. The station numbers used for the computer check are to be indicated on each print and identified on the printout.

If it seems obvious that there may be difficulties encountered by the plan examiner due to either the complexity of the plan, the type of printout or the method used, please attach a note of explanation.

Any exceptions to this directive must be approved by this office prior to submission of the returns.
