Please be advised that prior to the commencement of any survey work for any purpose within or on the perimeter boundaries of a Provincial Park or Protected Area, land surveyors are required to seek survey instructions from the office of the Surveyor General.

To obtain survey instructions, please describe the intended purpose of the survey and provide a sketch plan depicting the extent of the survey within the park or protected area to this office. We encourage the use of electronic submissions. Upon receipt and review of your documentation, we will provide guidance and key information to assist with the conduct of the survey.
