CIRCULAR LETTER TO ALL BRITISH COLUMBIA LAND SURVEYORS

Sir:

Re: General Instructions for surveys
in Integrated Survey Areas.

Attached herewith is a copy of B. C. Reg. 84/67 issued under authority of Official Surveys Act Amendment Act 1964.

It is expected that very shortly the Lieutenant Governor in Council will constitute by regulation, "Integrated Survey Area No. 1" which area is located in the northwesterly portion of the Corporation of the District of Surrey. After such constitution, the Integrated Survey plan will be deposited in the New Westminster Land Registry Office and thereafter cadastral surveys carried out in such area shall be in accordance with the aforesaid Act and this Regulation .

For the information of all B. C. Land Surveyors who operate in the Fraser River area a "Plan of Control Survey of part of the Fraser River between Annacis Island and Pitt River" has been accepted in the New Westminster Land Registry Office as DF C19606. Although such plan does not as yet comprise an "Integrated Survey Area" it is understood that many surveyors in that section would prefer at this stage to tie in cadastral surveys to this control. This they are encouraged to do where convenient, and to this end, also filed in the New Westminster Land Registry Office are separate sheets giving details of each coordinate control monument shown on the plan.
