CIRCULAR LETTER TO ALL BRITISH COLUMBIA LAND SURVEYORS

Sir:

Re: Tape Standardization Base
Municipality of Surrey.

This is to advise that a two-hundred-foot tape standardization base was established by the Municipality of Surrey and in August 1968 the Surveys and Mapping Branch of the Department of Lands, Forests and Water Resources calibrated the base. It is now available for use by B. C. Land Surveyors and others.

The base is marked by three copper nails leaded into the concrete pad at the north entrance area to the Surrey Municipal Hall, - 14245 56th Avenue. The distances tabulated below refer to the distances between points which are marked by the centre of the copper nail heads. The base runs from West to East and the extremity of the westerly bay lies opposite the rear entrance doors to the main section of the Municipal Hall.

Base Values - August 1968.

Westerly bay - 100.005'

Easterly bay - 99.999'
