CIRCULAR LETTER TO ALL BRITISH COLUMBIA LAND SURVEYORS

Re: Survey Instructions for Crown Land

In accordance with the Ministry's revised policy for processing Crown land applications, it will no longer be necessary for the Land Surveyor to apply directly to the Surveyor General for survey instructions.

Commencing October 1, 1982, the applicant will supply the Regional Office with a Land Surveyor's letter of commitment to carry out the survey. This letter will be forwarded to the Victoria Office along with other required information pertaining to the application. When all is in order, survey instructions will be issued by the Surveyor General to the appointed Land Surveyor.

In case the required survey instruction fee is not submitted by the applicant along with the letter of commitment to the Region, the letter of survey instructions will request the fee be paid at the time the survey returns are submitted to the Ministry for processing.
