## CIRCULAR LETTER TO ALL BRITISH COLUMBIA LAND SURVEYORS

## Statutory Rights of Way Plans

The section in Circular Letter #313 which requires that boundaries of existing rights of way be depicted, with solid lines, on plans creating new rights of way, is hereby rescinded. Henceforth the above-mentioned existing rights of way are to be indicated by broken lines.

## Land Title Office Plan Approvals

Also effective upon receipt of this letter, three paper prints of the above plan of Crown land requiring the approving officer's signature are to be submitted to this office instead of the present requirement of two. This extra print is needed to update the approving officer on the condition(s) of our approval of your plan.

## British Columbia Geographic System

On all future Land Act survey plans, the British Columbia Geographic System (BCGS) designation shall be shown beneath the plan title. This will supersede the use of the National Topographic System (NTS) notation called for by Section 88(2)(d) of the General Survey Instructions.

The six minute latitude by twelve minute longitude breakdown shall be used, for example: 93 G.018.

The BCGS designation will now appear on all Land Act survey instructions issued by this office.
