

**CIRCULAR LETTER NO. 485**

**TO ALL BRITISH COLUMBIA LAND SURVEYORS**

**Re: Integrated Survey Area No. 28, City of Campbell River, Updated  
Boundary**

---

Under the authority of section 12(1) of the *Land Survey Act*, the boundaries of Integrated Survey Area (ISA) No. 28, City of Campbell River are redefined by order of the Surveyor General effective November 16, 2020. This redefinition is necessary in order to include previously set ISA Monuments that had been omitted from the prior ISA boundary at the north end of Campbell River and to clarify the existing boundaries in all other areas.

An electronic map of the location and extent of Integrated Survey Area No. 28 is published in the *ParcelMap BC Search for Land Surveyors* view on myLTSA under the authority of section 13(3) of the *Land Survey Act*. Indian Reserves are excluded from the ISA even if they are shown mapped within an ISA boundary. ParcelMap BC shows the location and designation of the coordinate control monuments on the '**Survey Features**' → '**Survey Control**' layer and the boundary of the Integrated Survey Areas on the '**Survey Features**' → '**Integrated Survey Areas**' layer.

A user may also link to the [MASCOT](#)<sup>1</sup> Survey Control Database to obtain control monument sketches and detailed coordinate information and revision history. To invoke this function within ParcelMap BC, turn on the '**Survey Control**' layer to see the location of all monuments. Click on the desired monument location or use the 'Search by Shape' tool to select multiple monuments; in the Search Results pane on the right side of the screen the monument(s) will be listed by GCM number and when hovered over there is a link to 'Search MASCOT' which will bring up the long form monument datasheet in MASCOT.

Legal surveys within Integrated Survey Area No. 28 must be completed in compliance with the requirements under Rule 2-3 of the Survey and Plan Rules and Section 14 of the *Land Survey Act*.
