TO ALL BRITISH COLUMBIA LAND SURVEYORS
AND REGISTRARS, LAND REGISTRY OFFICES.

Amongst other things the B.C. Regulations Act, 1958, calls for the filing of all Surveyor-General's Regulations or Instructions with the Registrar appointed under the Act, who will thereupon publish them in the British Columbia Gazette, Part II.

This requirement has provided the opportunity for completely revising the "General Instructions" of May 1922, under the Land Act, as well as the "Manual Respecting the Survey of Mineral Claims and Placer-Mining Leases in British Columbia" under the Mineral Act and Placer-Mining Act. All other Regulations have been amended in various degrees and the complete set is contained in punched booklet form herewith.

These Regulations became effective on November 12, 1959, and supersede all previously issued Regulations or Instructions under the Acts specified.

In the case of surveys unfinished on the ground, the surveyor may complete same under the Regulations in force at the time of commencement of the survey. However, wherever possible the surveyor should complete the survey and preparation of the returns under the new Regulations.
