CIRCULAR LETTER TO ALL BRITISH COLUMBIA LAND SURVEYORS

Sir:

Re: General Instructions to B. C. Land Surveyors. B. C. Regulation 301/59 -Land Act Survey Instructions

The connections of current surveys in progress to previous surveys as required by section 3.03 of this Regulation have heretofore been paid for, to private surveyors, at the rates prescribed in section 6.01.

The Honourable, the Minister of Lands, Forests and Water Resources has now authorized an increase in these rates to double the 1959 figures.

Henceforth the new rates will be:

\$200 per mile for any excess over one half mile in heavily wooded country.

\$120 per mile for any excess over one mile in open or partly open country, along trails, roads, ice or open foreshore.

These rates are in effect immediately and will appear as an amendment in Part II of the B. C. Gazette at the first opportunity.
