CIRCULAR LETTER TO ALL BRITISH COLUMBIA LAND SURVEYORS

Sir:

Re: General Instructions to B. C. Land  
Surveyors, B. C. Regulation 301/59  
Land Act Survey Instructions

The connections of surveys in progress to previous surveys as required by Section 3.03 of this Regulation have heretofore been paid for, to private surveyors, at the rates prescribed in Section 6.01 as amended by my circular letter of August 13, 1963.

Henceforth the new rates will be:

\$250 per mile for any excess over one half mile in heavily wooded country.

\$150 per mile for any excess over one mile in open or partly open country, along trails, roads, ice or open fore-shore.

These rates are in effect immediately and will appear as an amendment to the Regulations at the first opportunity.
