Re: Survey Control in N.E. B.C.

The Surveys and Mapping Branch now has available for distribution, seven (7) index maps at a scale of 1 inch to 2 miles covering National Topographic Map Series Sheets 94I E, 94I W, 94J E, 94O E, 94O W, 94P E and 94P W.

These map sheets show all official triangulation and tellurometer traverse control stations with connecting rays.
