CIRCULAR LETTER TO ALL BRITISH COLUMBIA LAND SURVEYORS

Dear Sir:

Re: Integrated Survey Area No. 1.

For your information 2 new control monuments have been created under Sec. 7.02 of Integrated Survey Regulations, B. C. Reg. 240/70.

They apply to Sheet No. 1 of Integrated Survey Area No. 1 and are as follows:-

Monument 5891 - located on the approximate centre line of 127th Street, approximately 300 feet north of 104th Avenue.

Monument 5892 - located on the west side of 128th Street, approximately 300 feet north of 104th Avenue.

The coordinate values and other survey data for these have now been supplied to, and are on record in, the New Westminster Land Registry Office. In the future further supplementary certificates covering new coordinate control monuments will be forwarded from time to time to the pertinent Land Registry Office. It is not considered necessary to advise you by letter each time this happens but it will be advisable for you to check Land Registry Office records for such supplementary certificates.
