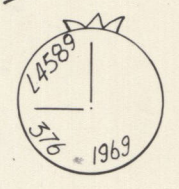
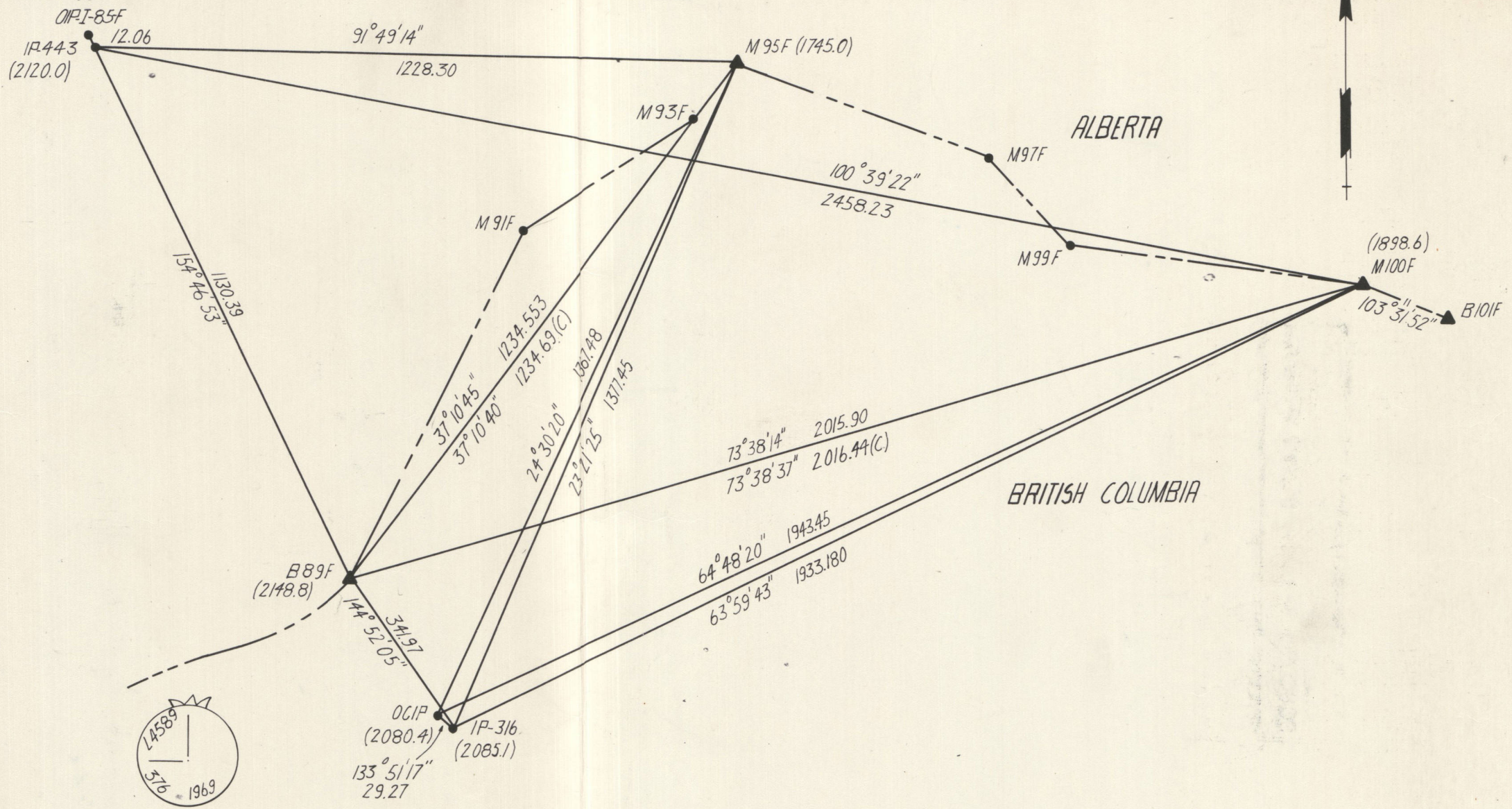


**PLAN OF SURVEY OF THE REFERENCING OF THE
